Membership Rules

Permanent Membership

- The membership is open to residents of Delhi/NCR, who are >18 years of age. Children between the ages of 5-18 years can avail this member by providing a declaration by their parents or guardian.
- Membership is given upon one-time payment of a refundable security deposit of Rs. 500/- along with a registration fee of Rs. 100/-.
- Membership requires a copy of a Voter ID or an Aadhar card for proof of identity and residence. In the case of a minor, a Voter ID or Aadhar card of the parent or guardian is accepted.
- Enrolment is processed on all working days between 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Temporary Membership

- Temporary membership is free for outstation experts and research scholars for 15 days.
- Temporary membership is only for reference. The use of reading room is allowed and books are not to be issued.

Staff Membership

- Membership is free for NBT Employees.
- This membership is valid till the date of retirement.
- After retirement, new membership upon payment of Rs. 600/- can be applied for.

General Rules

- The Membership Card and Reader's Tickets shall not be transferable in any case. Members have to get books issued personally and also return them personally.
- A change of address and phone number must be informed without fail.
- Personal books are not allowed in the library.
- Members are entitled to two books or magazines issued at a time for a period of 15 days.
- If books are not returned by the due date, a fine of Rs. 2/- per day will be charged per book.
- In the event of loss and/or damage, Members will be required to either replace the same book or pay the present price of the book.
- Reference books, board books and CDs/DVDs will not be issued.
- Readers can visit the library and read library books during the working hours of the library.



NCCL Library is open from Monday to Friday (10 AM to 5 PM).
The library remains closed on all government holidays.
