

Subject: Invitation for participation and submission of books in Book Collection Programme at Pune, Maharashtra for Library-cum-Book Promotion Centre (Nagpur).

Dear Sir/Madam,

National Book Trust, India is in the process of establishing a **Library-cum-Book Promotion Centre at Koradi, Nagpur, Maharashtra**. As part of this initiative, books published by publishers from Maharashtra state are proposed to be collected for consideration and inclusion in the Centre in Marathi, Hindi and English languages. In this connection, publishers and distributors are cordially invited to submit their books in **Marathi, Hindi and English** for review and selection purposes. The initiative aims to promote quality literature and facilitate wider access to books for readers, students, researchers and library users.

For the convenience of publishers, a dedicated programme for submission and presentation of books and catalogues is being organized in Pune as per the following schedule:

Date: 21.05.2026, Thursday, 11 AM – 5 PM
22.05.2026, Friday, 10 AM – 4 PM

Venue: National Book Trust India, Western Regional Office, India Survey No. 85, Ganaraj Chowk, Baner, Pune - 411045 (Maharashtra)

The following points may kindly be noted:

1. The books submitted should comprise important and representative titles of the concerned publisher/distributor in Marathi, Hindi and English languages.
2. The submitted titles shall undergo a selection process by the concerned committee, which may also include representatives from the publishing fraternity and subject experts, as deemed appropriate.
3. A Vigilance Committee shall be constituted to ensure a fair, transparent and systematic process of submission and selection of books.
4. The selection process and related administrative formalities shall be carried out by National Book Trust, India.
5. Books under the scheme may be considered for procurement at the prevailing institutional discount rates as per the norms and policies of National Book Trust, India. Books under the scheme shall ordinarily be considered for procurement at a discount **45%**.

Publishers are requested to ensure submission of their books along with the relevant catalogues, title lists and publication details within the stipulated date and time.

Further details regarding submission guidelines and related formalities shall be shared subsequently.

National Book Trust, India is looking forward to your valued participation and cooperation in strengthening this important initiative for promotion of books and reading culture.
