**Quality of paper/card vis-a-vis quoted rate shall be the main criteria for the selection/purchase of paper. The suppliers have to make their supplies conforming to the standard laid down by the NBT and BIS.**

Tender Form can be obtained from the office of Joint Director (Production), National Book Trust, India, on any working day from **10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** on payment of **Rs.2000.00** (Rupees Two Thousand) in cash or by Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of **National Book Trust, India** payable at **Delhi/New Delhi**. The tender document can also be downloaded from the website **www.nbtindia.gov.in** and deposited alongwith the cost of the tender form on or before the last date.

Only authorized dealers/distributors are eligible for submitting the tenders. They have to submit an authorisation letter from the mill(s) along with the request letter for the purchase of Tender Document. The format of authorisation letter may be downloaded from NBT website. Tenders complete in every respect may be submitted on or before the last date.
