2. Project Profile & Background Information

2.1. About Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya

The Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya, a one of its kind digital library, facilitates availability of quality non-academic books across geographies, languages, genres and levels, and enables device agnostic accessibility. The Digital Library consists of non-academic books for children and adolescents categorized in four age groups i.e., 3-8, 8-11, 11-14, and 14+ years respectively. The books cover different genres for children and adolescents like fiction, non-fiction, biographies, poetry, classics, comics, novels, etc. The repository of books in Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya focus on history, culture, scientific achievements, and other significant facets of India.

For providing access, applications have been developed for the initiative, which currently hosts over 7000+ books sourced from more than 250+ publishers, in 25+ languages, and spanning across 21 genres. The Android and iOS applications may be downloaded from the Google Play Store and Apple App Store respectively. 2.2. About National Book Trust, India

The National Book Trust (NBT), India, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education, was established in 1957 to promote literacy and reading culture. Its main objectives include the production, publication, and distribution of high-quality, affordable books, and promoting literacy across India. The NBT organizes various initiatives such as book fairs, seminars, and workshops, and supports authors and publishers. It publishes a diverse range of books and distributes them across India and internationally. The NBT has been recognized for its

contributions to literature and literacy in India and confers awards like the National Book Awards.

The National Book Trust (NBT), India — the nodal body for promoting a reading culture and fostering book development in the country — plays a key role in publishing books for children and adolescents, and is also actively engaged in the production of e-books. NBT has been entrusted with the responsibility of managing the operations, maintenance, and enhancement of the Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya digital platform.

As part of this initiative, NBT aims to expand the platform's collection of non-academic digital books in multiple Indian languages and to actively engage a wide audience of children and adolescents through rich and diverse content.

In this context, Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat at the National Book Trust, India, is inviting publishers who share a passion for promoting reading habits to collaborate with us. We seek collaboration with publishers who are committed to enriching young minds and are interested in contributing to this national effort to make reading accessible and enjoyable for all.

3. Scope of work

The scope of work in this section is not exhaustive and the empanelled publishers may have to undertake other responsibilities as may be necessary or incidental to accomplish the objectives outlined in this EoI.

The empanelled publishers are expected to adhere to the below mentioned scope of work:

1. The empanelled publishers shall provide acceptable and age-appropriate e-books for ages 8–11, 11–14, and 14+ (Young Adults) across genres such as Classics, Mystery, Thriller, Historical, Fiction, Science and Technology, Sports and Fitness, Adventure, etc., with a special emphasis on promoting Indian Knowledge System, rich history, traditions and achievements of India. The books shall be specifically suitable for readers aged 14+ years. Please note that the list of genres is indicative in nature only and may be expanded.
2. The empanelled publisher must provide e-books in the specified formats, namely, ePUB / searchable PDF that can be accessed on Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya app after the successful selection of titles by the Committee.
3. The empanelled publishers must ensure to take all the necessary consent and approvals from the authors / illustrators / artists / translators / legal owners etc. or their legal heirs of the intellectual properties as per the Copyright Act, 1957 and the Copyright Rules, 2013 prior to making the e-books available on the Rashtriya e-

Pustakalaya platform. Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya or Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat, at National Book Trust, India shall, in no way, be responsible for any claims from authors / illustrators / artists / translators / legal owners etc. or their legal heirs of the intellectual properties as per the Copyright Act, 1957 and the Copyright Rules, 2013 for any material sourced from the empanelled publishers.

4. The empanelled publishers shall ensure necessary licensing agreements for any sourced material and adherence to copyright laws for uninterrupted hosting and access on Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya. This may include, but not be limited to, extending contracts with the respective copyright holders at their own cost.
5. The empanelled publishers shall have to ensure that the contents are relevant to the specific age groups and to the target groups of the Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya platform with special emphasis on promoting Indian Knowledge System, rich history, tradition and achievements of India.
6. The empanelled publishers must provide content having ISBN / RNI registrations only.
7. The empanelled publishers shall provide the metadata of the e-books in the format provided and ensure periodic updates, if any, regarding the same.

4. Eligibility criteria

The criteria given in the succeeding paragraphs must strictly be fulfilled by the publisher. The publisher must submit documentary evidence in support of their claim for fulfilling the criteria and they should submit an undertaking on their letter heads to the fairness of these documents in support of their claim while submitting the Bid(s). The bids received without documentary evidence will be outrightly rejected.

The publisher participating in the procurement/empanelment process shall possess the following minimum pre-qualification/ eligibility criteria.

5.1 The Expression of Interest (EoI) can be downloaded from the website www.nbtindia.gov.in and www.ndl.education.gov.in

- 5.2** Interested applicants are advised to study the document carefully. Submission of responses shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the document with full understanding and its implications.
- 5.3** The Publisher shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and Content Procurement Committee, Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat at National Book Trust, India will be in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bid process.
- 5.4** Each offer shall specify only a single response meeting the specifications and it is the responsibility of the Publisher to decide the most appropriate solution to meet the specified requirements.
- 5.5** Publishers are neither allowed to join hands to participate in the tender nor allowed to submit multiple bids. In case of detection of such, their responses (s) is/are liable to be rejected.
- 5.6** The publisher is allowed to submit maximum of **100 titles per bid**. Any titles submitted beyond this limit shall not be considered for review.
- 5.7** The publisher must submit one copy each in printed book format to Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat within one week of submission of EoI.
- 5.8** The Competent Authority of Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat at National Book Trust, India reserves the right to empanel any publisher or cancel the process without assigning any reason. In case of differences, if any, the decision of the Competent Authority of Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat, at National Book Trust, India shall be final. Multiple agencies may be empanelled as per the requirement of Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya. Initially the empanelment will be for three years and can be extended up to five years at the discretion of competent authority. The empanelment shall, however, be subject to an annual review, and the continuation of individual titles on the Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya platform shall be subject to the requirements and suitability of Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya. Accordingly, certain titles may be discontinued or removed from the platform based on the outcome of such review or as deemed appropriate by the Competent Authority.
- 5.9** The Competent Authority of Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat at National Book Trust, India reserves the right to accept any response under this EoI in full or in part, or to reject any response or all responses without assigning any reason.

- 5.13** To assist in the examination, evaluations, and comparison of responses, the Competent Authority of Rashtriya e-Pustakalaya Secretariat at National Book Trust, India may, at its sole discretion, ask the participating publishers for clarification on the responses submitted. The request for clarification shall be in writing, through e-mail. The response shall be submitted in writing by the authorised representative of the Publisher. If the response to the clarification is not received before the expiry of deadline prescribed in the request, the submission may subject to be rejected. No representation in this regard would be entertained after such rejection of the responses.
- 5.14** The response document should be electronically/type-written and there should not be any overwriting. The response Document shall be signed by a person duly authorized by the Publisher.
- 5.15** The person signing the response Document shall sign and stamp at the bottom of all pages of the Response Document and each page of the response document should be properly numbered and submitted as a package along with forwarding letter on Participating publisher's letter head. Any correction/overwriting/cutting/use of whitener etc. may lead to rejection of the Response.
- 5.16** All the Participating Publishers have to abide by all the terms and conditions mentioned in this Eol document.
- 5.17** Information relating to the clarification, evaluation and comparison of Responses, and recommendations for the award of the empanelment shall not be disclosed to Participating Publishers or any other persons until the award of empanelment to the successful Publisher has been announced.

- 5.19** Any response received by ReP, NBT-India after the deadline for submission of Responses prescribed in this document, will be summarily rejected and returned unopened to the Publisher. ReP, NBT-India shall not be responsible for any delay or non-receipt / non-delivery of the documents. No further correspondence on this subject will be entertained.
- 5.20** ReP, NBT-India will open Expression of Interest (Eoi) as per schedule. The participating publisher may depute their authorised representative for the event. The Participating Publisher's representative who is present shall sign the attendance roll evidencing his/her attendance. Even if no representative of the Participating Publisher is available, the Expression of Interest (Eoi) would be opened as per schedule. In the event of the specified date being declared a holiday the Expression of Interest (Eoi) shall be opened at the appointed time and location on the next working day.
- 5.21** The Response to EOI shall be submitted duly filled by downloading Eoi document from website. Response to EOI may be rejected at any stage of the evaluation if it is found that any participating publisher has provided misleading information or has been blacklisted by a Central or a State government or has indulged in malpractice/unethical practice or not honoured contractual obligation elsewhere.
