National Book Trust, India (NBT), an autonomous organization of the Government of India, Ministry of Education has decided to auction the following Two Exhibition Vans on as is where is basis:-

2. Sealed quotations/rates are invited for disposal of aforesaid two Exhibition Vans (TATA) on the terms and conditions mentioned below. Interested parties may submit their highest rates in a sealed envelope with amount offered for each vehicle on the letter head duly signed in the enclosed proforma addressed to National Book Trust, India, Nehru Bhawan, 5 Institutional Area, Phase-II, Vasant Kunj, New Delhi – 110 070 and **dropped in the Tender Box placed at the above address from 9.00 am to 3.00 pm latest by 23.03.2021.** In case of cutting/ overwriting the bid will be rejected. In case of variation in quoted rates in words and figures the rates in word will be considered as final.
3. The two vehicles will be available for inspection from 11.00 AM to 3.00 PM on all working days from **15.03.2021 to 23.03.2021.** The quotations received in time will be opened by the Tender Committee on **24.03.2021 at 11.00 AM** in the committee Room of NBT Head office. The Bidders or their representative (not more than one) if they so desire may be present, at the time of opening of quotations.
4. Late Bids i.e. bids received after the specified time and date of receipt will not be considered.
5. The Bidders are required to submit their bid applications alongwith an Earnest Money Deposit of ₹25,000/- by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of **National Book Trust, India, New Delhi.**

6. The auction will be governed by the following terms & conditions:-
- i. The successful bidder will be required to deposit the balance bid amount after adjustment of Earnest Money of ₹25,000/- latest within one week of opening of bids by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "**National Book Trust, New Delhi**".
 - ii. The delivery of the sold two vehicles will be handed over only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of identity and residential status (Ration Card/Voter Identity Card/ Aadhar Card in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms /companies).
 - iii. The entire set of Tender paper issued to the Bidder should be submitted fully priced and also duly sealed & signed on all pages, Initial/signature will indicate the acceptance of the tender papers by the Bidders.
 - iv. The successful bidder shall have to surrender the cut part of the chassis numbers to NBT after scrapping the vehicles. An undertaking to this effect will have to be submitted alongwith the quotation which will legally bound the bidder for the same.
 - v. The sold vehicles shall have to be removed by the successful bidder immediately at his own expenses.
 - vi. The vehicles are being disposed off on **as is where is basis** and no guarantee for road worthiness or quality will be given by NBT.
 - vii. The vehicles having been scrapped shall not be allowed to ply on the road. Hence no Registration Certificate and ownership transfer documents will be handed over to the successful bidder.
 - viii. If the successful bidder withdraws his/her bid the Earnest Money will be forfeited.
 - ix. Subsequent to handing over possession of the auctioned vehicles, NBT will not be responsible for any legal issue related to these vehicles.
 - x. NBT reserves the right to accept or reject any/all the quotations without assigning any reasons, whatsoever.
